



OUR FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to book?

Bookings are recommended – please call or email. Groups of 8 or more MUST book. During the Christmas/New Year period and Easter we can get busy so please book ahead of time to avoid disappointment.

Are you open public holidays?

Yes – we are open on public holidays.

Can I bring my own fishing gear (bait, rods etc)?

Sorry, no. We only allow Grab A Barra rods and tackle to be used due to the risk of introduced bacteria into our farm waterway and also to protect your equipment from tangles and damaged caused by other people fishing at the same time as you.

Can I bring my own food and drinks?

No food or drink is to be brought on to the property (excluding baby food and water).

Do you have food and drinks available?

We have tea and coffee facilities available.

Do you have a cancellation policy?

Yes – please see our Terms & Conditions.

What if I want to stay longer than my booking? How do I add more time?

Please make yourself known to a staff member. If we are not exceeding the maximum number of people per timeslot and we can accommodate a longer session, you can pay for the extra time on the day.

Is my fish included in my entry fee? How do I pay for the fish I catch?

Caught fish are not included in the entry fee. If you catch a Barra and would like to take it home, it will be weighed and paid for at market price after your session.

If I am not fishing, just watching, do I have to pay?

No – spectators do not have to pay entry.

Is there an age limit?

We welcome people of all ages to the farm. The waterways are unfenced and we are situated in crocodile territory, children of all ages must have a responsible adult with them at all times.

Is there wheelchair accessibility?

Yes.

Are there toilet facilities?

Yes.

Are there undercover areas for shelter?

Yes.

Can I bring my dog?

Sorry, no. We do not allow dogs at the farm with the exclusion of registered guide or companion dogs. Visitors arriving with dogs will be asked to leave – dogs cannot be left in cars, trucks, cages or tied up.

What should I wear?

Appropriate footwear must be worn and sufficient sun protection (sunscreen, hats, long sleeves) are recommended. Hats and sunscreen will be available for purchase.

Am I guaranteed to catch a fish?

Yes.

Will I still catch a fish when it's raining?

Yes.

Do you have a bag limit?

If you catch a monster size, it was recommended not to kill the fish. In these conditions, we recommend to release it, and we can substitute that with a fresh barramundi that is smaller size. The number of fish is up to you – you will pay by the kilo for the fish you have caught.

What kind of fish do you stock?

We only have Saltwater Barramundi.
